CLASS OF 1959 REUNION ROCKS!

The La Puente-Pomona area saw a gathering of nearly 200 Warriors and affiliated tribespeople during October 13-15, as the Class of 1959 celebrated the 50th anniversary of their breakout from the LPHS reservation in June 1959. The Pow-Wow was held at the Kellogg West Lodge on the Cal Poly campus in Pomona. Our reporters witnessed an even 100 Warriors from 1959, plus others from the affiliated tribes of 1952 through 1963. The event drew attendees from fifteen states and three provinces, gathering at the first big Pow-Wow since 2004.

Warriors conferred from noon on October 13 until noon of the 15th, with a dinner on the 14th and a brunch on the 15th. In addition, some of the papooses had a private lunch on the 14th (see *Papoose Page*). Some of the tribal elders were also in attendance (see *Teacher's Lodge*).

The Hospitality Room, open for the entire Pow-Wow, was a warm place for old friends to meet and relax, while the Kellogg West Lodge was a cozy Dinner/Brunch venue.







(at left) Art teacher and coach Wm. "Lefty" Fontenrose was visited at the Brunch by his former students, but we didn't get his photo!






WHOOPING WARRIORS SWAMP WIGWAM









THE CLASS OF 1959

We count 414 Warriors in the Tribe of '59, including all who attended LPHS during our senior year. The list below includes all 414. WHERE DID WE COME FROM? We came from all over! About 47% of our tribe were born in California, and the rest in at least 32 other states plus Puerto Rico, and at least 5 foreign countries (See the map below.) About 2/3 of us were born in 1941, the rest in 1940 and 1942, except a very few in 1939. Congratulations - we're now all well past 65 and into our Golden (?) Years!

WHERE DID WE GO? Over the years, our 330+ living classmates have spread across 30 states, plus Canada, Puerto Rico, and Taiwan. Only 47% are still in So. Calif., and 10% in No. Calif. Most of the rest are in the Western states.


